

## Accusative Case

The Accusative case:

1. Indicates the direct object - something directly affected by the action.
2. Used after the following prepositions:  
**в** - to, into, **за** - for, behind, **на** - to, onto, **под** - under, **про** - about, **че́рез** - through, across.
3. Time expressions with **весь** - all and **каждый** - every, followed by a time period.
4. To express a physical state:  
 Девушку знобит. The girl has chills. Мальчика тошнит. The boy feels nauseated.
